

# The role of Performance Management Reviewer of the Headteacher

**Tuesday 16 October (19.00 - 21.00)**

**Target Audience:** *Governors who are new to the role of the performance reviewer for the headteacher.*

**Aim:** To assist governors in being effective in the role of PM reviewer.

This session follows on from the sessions which ran in the Summer Term 2007 on the revised regulations for school performance management. It is designed to assist those new to the role to carry out their duties in this year's review and planning meeting of the headteacher's performance, which is due later this term in many schools. A more detailed course is under development, which will assist governors further in being familiar with the skills and knowledge of an effective reviewer. This interim training offer will draw upon some of the work to develop the new course, which will be in place from early 2008.

## **Content:**

- To enhance the interpersonal skills necessary to undertake headteacher performance management and the setting and reviewing of objectives in the context of whole school improvement;
- To gain further understanding of the national requirements, the Bracknell Forest Model Performance Management Policy and the support available;
- To be clear of the legal parameters under which the performance management of headteachers must be conducted and its relationship to pay.
