Training and Lesson Materials for Schools

Anger Management Activity	A one lesson activity built around a set of prescribed problems, what are the variety feelings and discussions around ideas for solutions
Diversity Group Activities for a Year 7 Induction Day	An initial team building activity that encourages partnership working and team work
Examining the Media Year 10	A workshop to examine the role of the media in relation to racism, looking at the dangers of labelling people and the impact of inadequate media reporting
Challenging Stereotypes KS 3	A 4 session pack dealing with name calling, bullying, challenging stereotypes (Refugees, Gypsies and some other groups) and a session about racism and the law
Traveller Time Lines A KS 3 History Lesson	Using a time line to select, organise and recall historical information based on Gypsy Traveller history
The Fair KS 2	6 cross-curricular anti-racist lessons covering fairgrounds, Show People's lives, shared needs and racism
Respect KS 3	6 PHSE lessons focusing on identity, diversity and racism
Media Representation KS 3	2 literacy lessons dealing with differences and similarities between British newspapers, developing a journalistic style and identifying the different points of view and styles of the media
SPOTLIGHT KS3/4	A pack for 4 small group sessions. It aims to give students opportunities to develop skills to understand and assess their own lives and the world they live in.
Diversity Lesson Plan Pack KS2	A one-lesson plan with the objective to understand what racial insults are and why they are unacceptable. A stand alone pack or it can linked into Literacy/Citizenship planning
Anger Management KS3	A 3 session minimum for pupils with the guiding principals that it's OK to feel angry, it's what we do with that anger that matters.
